✓ Screens for Lyme disease, Ehrlichia, and Anaplasmosis–serious but treatable infections if caught early. If positive, we provide the first round of antibiotics!

FELINE ASSURANCE - \$30 (FOR CATS)

Highly recommended if you have other cats at home!

✓ FeLV & FIV testing

✓ Checks for Feline Leukemia (FeLV) and Feline Immunodeficiency Virus (FIV) which are transmissible to other cats.
